

It is my pleasure to serve as your Mayor and I look forward to the opportunity to meet you. Again, welcome to the City of Elmendorf.



Each resident shall utilize the waste service provided by Tiger Sanitation. For the monthly rate, each residence receives a 95-gallon garbage and recycling cart. A resident may have no more than three additional 30gallon personally-owned trash bins or bags. All waste and recyclables must be placed at the curb prior to 7:00 AM every Friday. Collection will be delayed to Saturday during the weeks of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's.

Large bulky items like appliances and furniture are collected during the Spring and the Fall by curbside pick-up. These items should be placed in the curbside area of your residence the morning of the scheduled collection.

WATER & SEWER

The primary goal of the Water Department is to protect the health and general welfare of the citizens we serve by proper treatment, storage, and distribution of drinking water. The City not only services within the corporate city limits of Elmendorf but a large portion of the surrounding area. If you have an after-hour water related emergency, please call the after-hour line at 210-669-1270. Please visit <u>www.elmendorf-tx.com</u> to pay your water bill.

Understanding Rates for Water Service

For most residential customers your monthly water bill consists of a "Service Availability Charge" of \$64.43 and a "Water Acquisition Fee" of \$1.00. The Service Availability Charge is the amount that is charged to all customers for having access to the City's water system in an "on-demand" capacity whenever you want it, whether you choose to use it or not. The Water Acquisition Fee is intended to defray additional charges by one of the city's water suppliers (San Antonio Water System) as outlined in their take or pay contract with the City of Elmendorf. These two fees will be charged every month once a meter is installed. The Service Availability Charge includes the first 3000 gallons of water used at no additional cost to help defray the impact of this monthly fee. Any water usage above 3,000 gallons will be billed in excess of these two fees per the charts below. For those users requiring larger meters, the Service Availability Charge changes depending on meter size, location and type.

Other charges may apply, including fees for Garbage and/or Sewer service. Please see our Master Fee Schedule on our website at <u>www.elmendorf-tx.com</u> for a full list of potential city fees.

Water bills are due on the 15th of every month and after the 15th of the month a late penalty will be charged on the account. The late penalty is 10% of the balance due on your bill/account. You will then have through the 25th of the month to pay your water bill. If payment is not received on the 25th of the month, your water service will be disrupted/shutoff the following day. A \$50 administrative reset fee will be added to the account and in order to get services turned back on the full balance owed and \$50 administrative reset fee will need to be paid.

Public Safety

ANIMAL CONTROL

Dogs and cats must be licensed annually. Proof of rabies vaccination and a small fee payable at the Elmendorf City Hall are required to obtain the license. A maximum of four dogs/cats are allowed per household. Pets must be restrained at all times. To report violations or claim impounded animals, call the Elmendorf City Hall at 210-635-8210. A fee and proof of rabies vaccination is required to claim impounded animals.

FIRE PROTECTION

The City of Elmendorf is served by Bexar County Emergency Services District #10. The district is governed by a board of 5 commissioners. They must be residents or own property in their district. The commissioners gather once a month at a public meeting. Visit their website www.bcesd10.org for times and location of meeting. The fire station opened its doors in the summer of 2020, off Highway 181 and Loop 1604.

The Elmendorf Police Department is a regulated law enforcement agency. This means the Department meets stringent state standards set by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) in the areas affecting services to the community, training, and methods of management.

The City's elected officials believe "hometown" service is both needed and desired; therefore, the Department is very responsive to the needs of its citizens. The Department is dispatched by Bexar County Public Safety Dispatch. If you need a police officer at your residence or need to make a report and a crime is not in progress, you may reach the dispatch center by dialing 210-335-6000 or dial 911 for emergencies.



The City of Elmendorf is served by the City Council composed of a mayor and five councilmembers. Officials are elected to two-year terms. Visit the City's website for a complete list of officials, their term expiration dates, contact information, and for a complete text of the city's Municipal Code.

MEETINGS

The regular meetings of the City Council are held on the third Thursday of each month at 7:00 PM at the Elmendorf City Hall. All meetings are open to the public. Meeting minutes are available on the City's website.

City Hall is open 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday and is closed on major holidays. The City Hall provides a variety of services for residents, including water and trash collection, billing management, applications for permits, faxes and copies, notary, and municipal court.

Building Permit	A permit for the construction or alteration of any building or other structure and for the placing of any manufactured home or fully fabricated structure is required.
Burn Ban	No person may cause, suffer, allow, or permit any outdoor burning within the city during a period in which a burn ban is established by the Mayor.
City Cemetery	Only residents of the city may purchase plots in the city cemetery. Resident must provide a valid form of ID and current water bill as proof of residency.
Junk Vehicle (Nuisance)	A motor vehicle that displays an expired license or does not display a license plate; is wrecked, dismantled or inoperable and remains on property more than 30 consecutive days is declared a public nuisance.
Trash, Rubbish, etc. (Nuisance)	It shall be unlawful for any person to permit trash, rubbish, discarded furniture, household appliances, or any other objectionable, unsightly, or unsanitary matter to accumulate on property.
Weeds, Brush, & Grass (Nuisance)	It shall be unlawful for any person to allow weeds, brush, or grass to grow a height greater than 18 inches on property, including the front or side parkway between the property line or sidewalk, and rear or side walk and curb or rear or side parkway between the property line and alley, easement or traveled way, if any.
